CUPW Won Paid Maternity Leave that Benefits All Canadians?

In 1981 after a 42-day strike, the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) won postal workers across Canada 17 weeks of paid maternity leave.

The idea of extended paid maternity leave beyond basic unemployment insurance benefits soon gained mainstream acceptance and spread nationwide.

URGE THE LIBERAL GOVERNMENT TO:

- Encourage free and open bargaining between Canada Post and CUPW members
- Reign in Canada Post CEO Doug Ettinger
- Expand Canada Post's retail and delivery services as proposed by CUPW members to include:
 - Postal banking
 - Check-in services
 - Community hubs and electric vehicle charging stations
- Restore and expand door-to-door delivery.
- Maintain the moratorium on post office closures.
