Corporations are swimming in profits because they exert undue influence on their political friends to get the things they want. Business lobbyists and the politicians they help elect try and distract us from our real concerns by talking about buck a beer or a two-month only 'GST holiday.'

Corporate-backed politicians like Conservatives Doug Ford and Pierre Poilievre, and Justin Trudeau's Liberals, have to stop

undermining public services including health care and education and the integrity of the workers who deliver them. It just makes privatization look more inviting when our public systems are left to fall apart.

Work Hard to Build Solidarity

Wealthy corporations and their political friends use hate and scapegoating to keep us weak and divided. They blame the affordability crisis and housing shortage on migrants, when corporations caused the problem. Instead of fighting each other, we need to stick together—just like we do at the bargaining table and when we join a solidarity picket.
